

PRAXIS: WORLD HISTORY FROM A CATHOLIC PERSPECTIVE

TABLE QUESTIONS

- I. Generally, is Christ, Who is truly the Center of the universe and of all history, manifest as the center of my "universe" and personal history? Consider those situations and times in my life where it is easy to see Christ at the center, and those situations and times where it is most difficult to see Christ at the center.

- II. In my "universe" and personal history (past or present), where do I fail to discern Christ's presence and activity? In my prayer, do I invite the Father, Son, or Holy Spirit
 - 1) to indicate His activity and presence in my sufferings and trials and
 - 2) to reshape my vision in regards to my "universe" and reinterpret the understanding of my history?

WEEKLY MISSION:

I- Morning Offering: (Apostleship Of Prayer)

II. 30 Minutes of mental prayer:

- A. 10 Minutes—Meditation on the Word
- B. 10 Minutes—Speaking or Writing to God (Father, Son, Holy Spirit)
- C. 10 Minutes—Listening to God (Father, Son, Holy Spirit)

III. Examination of Conscience: Presence of God

- A. Was my mind vigilant: conscience of the Presence of God and the fulfillment of His plan in each of the activities of this day? Did I ever offend God in my thoughts or indulge thoughts that took me away from Him or blocked His activity?
- B. Did I allow God to manifest His plan through my decisions and actions?
- C. Did my emotions help me to carry out and to see God's plan for holiness and love in my life, or did these emotions keep me from carrying out His plan and seeing the fruits of His Presence in my life and in others' lives?
- D. Did my bodily dress, gestures, postures, appearance, and expressions manifest the likeness of God to others and draw them to His holiness and love?
